The meeting place is outside the WH Smith outlet on the main concourse at Newcastle Central Station at 10.am There will be a break for lunch and we will finish at approx.

3.30pm. Transport to Newcastle is not included. There is a train from Berwick arriving at 9.55am and one departing Newcastle at 15.37pm on this day.

The route from the station will take in the Town Wall in Orchard St on the way down to the Quayside. We will look at the Castle and Black Gate, the medieval warehouse in Close and then on to timber - frame buildings in Sandhill and the Custom House. There will be a break for lunch, and in the afternoon we begin a second walk around the upper town with visits to Blackfriars and St Nicholas Cathedral.

You should be prepared for about 4 hours on your feet, with sensible footwear and waterproof clothing. There are cafes, pubs, or bring a packed lunch.

There will be a maximum of 15 places on the walk, so early booking is advised.

The cost of the guided walk is £12 .Please make your own way to Newcastle.

All are welcome and no previous knowledge is assumed.
