This five week course is aimed at those who would love to draw and paint but are completely terrified at the thought of 'not being good enough'. This will be a very gentle introduction into artistic practice. We will cover how to begin a drawing or painting, composition, different techniques and approaches, how to mix colour, which materials you should buy and those you shouldn't. The aim is to build confidence through experimentation and fun. Your tutor is an experienced educator and known for her kindness as well as her knowledge and enthusiasm for art.

1. Friday 10th May How to begin, pencil and charcoal drawing and composition basics
2. Friday 17th May Acrylic painting from still life
3. Friday 24th May Watercolour painting from still life
4. Friday 31st May Abstraction and mark making with collage
5. Friday 7th June Developing your own style

The cost of the course is £60, including refreshments. All are welcome and no previous knowledge is assumed.
