No two leaders, contemporary to each other, have attracted more attention from historians than Hitler and Stalin. It would be no exaggeration to say that their impact on European history in the 20th century is still evident today almost a century later.

Both were sworn enemies responsible for the deaths of millions and both represented ideologically opposed political systems of the right and left. Yet, paradoxically, they seemed to have shared as many similarities as differences.

Using the same title as Alan Bullock's influential study, this course seeks to explore some of these contradictions through the medium of eight power point presentations.
