This art workshop will explore the art of watercolour painting outdoors in the style of Turner, in the beautiful surroundings of Norham Castle.

We will be working on the riverbank in one of the places near where Turner is believed to have stood to sketch and paint Norham Castle. Paying close attention to the way Turner worked, you will be using the colours he used, but the final painting will be all your own.

You will be guided on how to achieve the best composition, producing the initial sketch and how to layer the colour in the way Turner worked.

The workshop will be equally suitable for beginners to intermediate students. More experienced artists wanting to practise working outdoors are just as welcome.

You are welcome to book both morning and afternoon sessions if you wish, working on one or several pieces. There are 10 spaces in each session.

Please bring sketching materials, watercolour paints and suitable paper. Stretched watercolour paper on a board may be useful for your final painting. Easels are provided.

We will be working outdoors so please dress appropriately for the weather, including sun hats and sunscreen. In the case of rain we will work under a garden gazebo.

There will be refreshments available from the Village Hall throughout the day. A free Turner - related art exhibition is on display at the Village Hall from Saturday 25th May for 1 week.

The cost of each session is £12. All are welcome
