After lunch you will use the Barns-Graham masterpieces in the gallery and the mornings experience to make an abstract (or semi abstract) art work. This will be a very tranquil and peaceful day and you will have the added bonus of a beautiful artwork to take home with you.

### **Materials**

You will need fine line pens or ink and dipping pens. Watercolour paper (preferably smooth) or very thick cartridge paper and coloured ink or watercolour paints and brushes. Easels are provided.
